

ORDINANCE NO. 21-37

By Mr. S. J. Altmaier.

Whereas, Calvin G. Eckstine and Blanche E. Eckstine are the owners of a tract 40 feet by 183.6 feet out of the southeast part of lot number Thirty-one (31) of Hamilton Gardens Subdivision, which premises front 40 feet upon Francis Avenue, and upon which they are constructing, or about to construct, a dwelling house, and there is now no public water main in front of said premises for the service thereof, and

Whereas, said parties have filed with the Clerk of Council their waiver wherein they propose and agree that in consideration of the granting to them permission to tap the water main now in Mound Street near the intersection thereof with Francis Avenue, and to lay a pipe in Francis Avenue from said tap to the north line of their said premises for the supply of water to said dwelling house, they do agree, for themselves, their heirs and assigns, that when a water line is constructed in Francis Avenue past their said premises, the same may be assessed for their proper proportion of the cost thereof, agreeing therein to waive the right to claim exemption from said assessment on the ground that said premises already have or may have adequate water service, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That in consideration of said proposal and agreement as hereinabove set forth permission be and hereby is granted to the said Calvin G. Eckstine and Blanche E. Eckstine to tap the water main now in Mound Street at the intersection of Francis Avenue therewith and to lay a pipe in said Francis Avenue from said tap to the north line of said Premises for the supply of water to the dwelling house erected or to be erected thereon, said permission, however, not to exempt said premises from the assessment of its proper proportion of the cost of any water main to be hereafter constructed in Francis Avenue past said premises.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
