ORDINANCE NO. 23-37

Granting permission to the White Castle System to cut curb and construct a drive at No. 2222 East Main Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the White Castle System, which is operating a refreshment and restaurant business on the following described premises:

Situated in the City of Bexley to-wit:

Being the southerly 100 feet of Lot No. 8 of G.W. Tussing's Subdivision, as numbered and delineated upon the recorded plat thereof, of record in the Recorder's Office, Franklin County? Ohio; said premises having a frontage of 58 feet on the northerly side of Main Street and extending northerly a width of 58 feet to a depth of 100 feet, said premises being also located at and known as No. 2222 East Main Street, Bexley, Ohio.

has requested permission to construct an 18 foot driveway into said premises for the accommodation of its customers, which will require the cutting of the curb on the north side of Main Street, and Councilbeing of the opinion that such permission should be granted for the construction of said driveway and the removal of the curb necessary therefor, said permission is hereby accordingly granted, and said White Castle System is authorized to construct such 18 foot driveway along the easterly side of said premises and to remove the curb to a distance of approximately 24 feet from the east line of said premises, being to the joint now in said curb.

At the west side of the entrance to said driveway said White Castle System shall construct a circular curb having a six foot radius and connecting with said north curb at the point to which said curb has been removed. In constructing said drive the gutters and sidewalks shall be restored to their present levels. All construction which shall be be street area shall be to the satisfaction of the engineers of the City of Bexley.

Section 2. At such time as said White Castle System shall cease to use said premises for its business, as hereinabove described, it shall upon demand of the City restore said curb at the entrance to said driveway to its present location and condition, and this ordinance shall not become effective until said, the White Castle System, shall accept in writing the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in

force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
