ORDINANCE NO. 24-37

By Mr. Stackhouse.

Providing for the repair of Gould Road from Main Street to Powell Avenue in cooperation with the City of Columbus, Ohio. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY; STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the City of Bexley shall cooperate with the City of Columbus in the repair of Gould Road from Main Street to Powell Avenue by re-grading and re-surfacing the roadway thereof with crushed stone.

Section 2. That crushed stone shall be-furnished by the City of Bexley in the approximate value of \$300.00, and labor shall be furnished by the City of Bexley in the approximate value of \$500.00.

Section 3. That the sum of \$300.00 is hereby appropriated from the Streets Maintenance and Repair Gasoline Tax Fund for the payment of the cost of said labor.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said Gould Road is dangerous to traffic and should be repaired at once, wherefore, said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
