ORDINANCE NO. 35-37

By Mr. Harlor--

Providing for the purchase of ornamental and shade trees.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he hereby is authorized to purchase shade and ornamental trees and cause same to be planted in the streets of the City of Bexley, in accordance with the regulations heretofore adopted by council.

Section 2. That the sum of \$400.00 is hereby appropriated from the park fund in the general fund to pay the cost of said trees.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
