

ORDINANCE NO. 5-38

By Mr. Sam Betz

To make additional appropriation for the payment of the cost of grading, materials and preliminary engineering services in the proposed improvement of Francis Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That to provide necessary additional funds with which to pay that part of the cost of the grading, necessary materials for the installation of the sanitary sewers, drains, and water lines, and preliminary engineering costs in the proposed improvement of Francis Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue, which are payable by the municipality under agreement entered into or to be entered into with the Works Progress Administration of the Federal Government for the doing of said work, there be and is hereby appropriated from the general fund the further sum of \$2500.00. Said general fund shall be reimbursed in the amount of said appropriation from the proceeds of either general revenue or special assessments bonds hereafter to be issued for the improvement of said street.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of said City, for which reason the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
