## ORDINANCE NO. 6-38

Appointing an Assistant Clerk of Council for the purpose of serving notices.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Theo. Petzinger be and he is hereby appointed an assistant clerk of council for the year 1938 for the purpose of serving notices of the passage of resolutions and other proceedings for street improvements, and such other notices and reports as are required by law to be served upon property owners, for which services he shall receive the sum of \$5.00 per day for each day actually engaged in such service and shall be reimbursed for his expenses. Said payments shall be included as a part of the cost of the improvements for which said notices and reports shall be served.

Section 2. The sum of \$\frac{5}{100.00}\$ is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the above purposes, which fund shall be reimbursed from any monies provided for the cost of the improvements for which said notices and reports shall be served.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
