

RESOLUTION NO. 11-38

Appointing Board to report estimated assessment to pay the cost and expense of improving Sherwood Road between Remington Road and Gould Road by constructing a black bituminous surface thereon.

Whereas, it has been determined by council to assess the whole cost of the improvement of Sherwood Road from Remington Road to Gould Road by constructing a black bituminous surface thereon in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That Walter E. Ludwig, W. D. Lavelly and Henry Lorenz, three disinterested freeholders of said city, be and they are hereby appointed a Board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith, as set forth in an Ordinance No. 29-38, to improve said street, passed June 28th, 1938, in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from the improvement to the several lots or parcels of land so assessed and report to this council the said estimated assessment.
