OF OHIO:

Appropriating money for the payment of that portion of the cost of the improvement of Havenwood Drive, North, between Euclaire Avenue and Cassingham Road, not to be borne by the Works Progress Administration and not to be especially assessed, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE

Section 1. That to pay the remaining portion of the cost of the improvement of Havenwood Drive, North, between Euclaire Avenue and Cassingham Road which is not to be borne by said Works Progress Administration, and not to be especially assessed, and which under the provisions of Resolution No. 4-38, passed March 22nd, 1938, providing for said improvement, shall be paid by the City, there is hereby appropriated from the Streets, Maintenance and Repair Gasoline Tax Fund the sum of \$1200.00.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said street is in an impassible condition and is in need of immediate repair, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
