

## ORDINANCE NO. 13-38

By Mr. Samuel Betz:-

Appropriating money for payment of repairs to lights during year 1937, and part of 1938.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the bill of Krebs Highway Marker, 74 South 18th Street, Columbus, Ohio, in the sum of \$127.00, for cleaning, adjusting, repairing and furnishing parts for lights on various streets and avenues in the City of Bexley for the year 1937 and part of 1938 be and the same is hereby approved and payment thereof authorized.

Section 2. That the sum of \$127.00 is hereby appropriated from Streets Maintenance and Repair Gasoline Tax fund for the payment of said bill.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
