ORDINANCE NO. 19-38

By Mr. Stackhouse:

Appointing three assistant clerks of Council for the purpose of serving notices, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEAVER, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That S. S. Hopkins, H. Grasse and \_\_\_\_\_, be

and they are hereby appointed assistant clerks of council for the year 1938 for the purpose of serving notices of the passage of resolutions and other proceedings for said improvement, and such other notices and reports as are required by law to be served upon property owners, for which services they shall each receive the sum of \$ 5 per day for each day actually engaged in such service and shall be re-imbursed for their expenses. Said payments shall be included as a part of the cost of the improvements for which said notices and reports shall be served.

Section 2. The sum of \$ 500 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the above purposes, which funds shall be reimbursed from any monies provided for the cost of the improvements for which said notices and reports shall be served.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that certain improvements are in progress for which notices must be served at once, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
