

## ORDINANCE NO. 21-38

By Mr. Sam Detz:-

Providing for the purchase of the necessary materials for the installation of house connections, or water services, on Francis Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized after advertisement according to law to enter into a contract for the purchase of the necessary house connections, or water services, for Francis Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue, and the Mayor is authorized to cause the same to be installed under the supervision of the engineers.


Section 2. That the cost of said water connections and services, and the installation thereof, shall be paid from the water fund and said fund shall be reimbursed by a service charge, which shall be made to the individual owner of the property so to be serviced at the time they shall connect therewith.

Section 3. That the sum of \$1500.00 is hereby appropriated from the water fund for the cost thereof.


Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


