

## ORDINANCE NO. 22-38

By Mr. Stackhouse-

Authorizing the City Solicitor to employ associate counsel in proceedings to issue bonds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the City Solicitor be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to employ the firm of Squire, Sanders & Dempsey, attorneys-at-law, of Cleveland, Ohio, to assist in the necessary proceedings to issue bonds for the following improvements, and to render their legal opinion upon said issues, to-wit:-

The improvement of Francis Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue.

The improvement of thirty alleys being improved in cooperation with the Works Progress Administration, at a consideration of not to exceed \$75.00 on said Francis Avenue, and \$150.00 on said alley improvement.

Section 2. The sum of \$225.00 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the cost and expense of said employment.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
