Providing for permits for sidewalks.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. No sidewalks shall hereafter be constructed, except as ordered by council, without a permit first obtained therefor. Permits for the construction of sidewalks shall be granted by the Superintendent of Buildings, and only upon written application signed by the owner or construction contractor, upon blanks furnished by the Superintendent of Buildings for that purpose. Provided, however, when such sidewalks are being constructed in connection with building improvements being constructed premises such application may be made upon the same applied for and a permit. After of \$1.50 shall be charged for each sidewalk permit. All sidewalks shall be constructed in accordance with the specifications now on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 2. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00, nor more than \$25.00, and shall pay the costs of prosecution.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and he in frace from and after the earliest period shlowed by law.
