

ORDINANCE NO. 42-38.

Authorizing the purchase of an automobile for the Department of Health, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one automobile coupe, with standard equipment, same not to exceed \$800.00 in price, and to exchange thereon one Harley-Davidson motorcycle, Twin 30, Manufacturer's Number 30 VL, Motor Number 7113, 24 Horse Power.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement had according to law. The sum of \$800.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Health Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the Health Department is in immediate need of said automobile for the transaction of its business, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
