By Mr. Stackhouse

Prohibiting the burning of rubbish, or other materials, in the public streets or alleys of the City of Bexley.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to burn or dause to be burned in any street, alley or public thoroughfare, in the City of Bexley, any leaves, grass, straw, hay or rubbish of any kind whatsoever.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction, be fined in a sum not less than \$5.00, and not more than \$25.00, and shall pay the costs of prosecution.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
