

ORDINANCE NO. 49-38

Authorizing the City Solicitor to employ assistant counsel in proceedings to issue bonds for the improvement of Roosevelt Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the City Solicitor be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to employ the firm of Squire, Sanders & Dempsey, attorneys-at-law, Cleveland, Ohio, to assist in the necessary proceedings to issue bonds for the improvement of Roosevelt Avenue from Broad Street to Fair Avenue, and to render their legal opinion upon said issue of bonds and the notes issued in anticipation thereof, at a consideration of \$35.00.

Section 2. The sum of \$35.00 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the cost and expense of said employment.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
