

RESOLUTION NO. 5-39

Amending Section 1 of Resolution No. 2-39, declaring it necessary to improve Remington Road from Maryland Avenue to Ruhl Avenue, adopted March 27, 1939.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Resolution No. 2-39, adopted March 27th, 1939, declaring it necessary to improve Remington Road from Maryland Avenue to Ruhl Avenue, by grading and paving the roadway thereof, constructing curbs and gutters, water connections and the necessary drains, in cooperation with the Works Progress Administration, and declaring an emergency, is amended to read as follows:-

Section 1. That it is necessary to improve Remington Road from Maryland Avenue to Ruhl Avenue, by grading and paving the roadway thereof with concrete foundation, with bituminous top, constructing curbs and gutters, water connections and the necessary drains to furnish proper drainage for said improvement, and constructing sidewalks on each side thereof, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of the proposed improvement heretofore prepared by the engineers and now on file in the office of the Mayor, which plans, specifications, estimates and profiles are hereby approved.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
