

ORDINANCE NO. 6-39

By Mr. O. F. Rehn

Accepting the plat of Park Drive Addition in the City of Bexley, and confirming the dedication of street, drive, park and alleys therein.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the plat of Park Drive Addition, being a subdivision of 5.01 acres of land, and being a part of Half Section 20, Section 13, Township 5, Range 22, Refugee Lands, be and the same is hereby approved and accepted, and that the dedication to public use of the street, drive, park and alleys shown thereon be and the same is hereby accepted and confirmed.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
