ORDINANCE NO. 8-39

To amend Section 4 of Ordinance No. 5-39, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 5-39,
"To cooperate with the City of Columbus in the construction
of storm sewers in Mound Street, Astor Avenue, and in Brownlee
Avenue and Kenwick Road in the City of Columbus, from approximately the east corporation line to the Bliss Run storm sewer,
and to appropriate funds to pay the City's portion of the cost
thereof," be amended to read as follows:-

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the territory served by said sewers is in need of immediate drainage, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
