

## ORDINANCE NO. 19-39

By Mr. Harlor

Providing for fixing of charge for water connections on water mains in Livingston Avenue from College Avenue to Euclaire Avenue, and water line connecting therewith in Francis Avenue.

Whereas, by Ordinance No. 35-34, duly passed on October 23rd, 1934, council provided for the construction of water mains in Livingston Avenue from College Avenue to Euclaire Avenue, and a water line connection therewith in Francis Avenue and extending northerly a distance of 330 feet, said construction to be in cooperation with the Federal Emergency Relief Administration, and the same to be paid for from the water fund in the sum of \$2500.00, and providing further that a proper charge should thereafter be fixed by council for water connections, which charge should be paid by the owners of properties bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the same to be paid at the time such connections are made, and the amounts charged therefor to be deposited to the credit of the water fund, from which said fund \$2500.00 was therein appropriated for the cost of said improvement, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is fixed as a proper charge for each of such water connections the sum of \$50.00, which amount shall be paid by the owners of the properties bounding and abutting upon said water lines on Livingston Avenue and on Francis Avenue in addition to the cost of making the tap, the same to be paid at the time of the making of such connections, and said amount so paid shall be deposited to the credit of the water fund in accordance with the terms of said Ordinance No. 35-34.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
