ORDINANCE NO. 27-39

To provide location and grade for sidewalks on the streets hereinafter named.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEALEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That when sidewalks are constructed on North Ardmore Road, North Cassingham Road and North Remington Road, between Broad Street and Meryland Avenue, the same shall be located so that the outside edge thereof, being the edge next to the curb, shall be located twenty-two feet from the center line of the respective streets whereon the same are constructed, and parallel to said center line; for the reason that the elevation of the sidewalk areas along said respective streets is uneven and irregular, so that it is impractical to construct said sidewalks at a uniform elevation with reference to the curbs, or to establish such uniform elevation, such sidewalks when constructed shall be constructed at such elevation as shall be furnished by the engineers to the respective property owners at the time they may construct sidewalks along their respective premises.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
