

ORDINANCE NO. 30-39

By Mr. Rehn

To authorize the Mayor to rent equipment for use in Works Progress Administration projects.

Whereas, the City of Bexley is without the necessary equipment for the various improvements that are being made by the City in cooperation with the Works Progress Administration, ^{that} and it is necessary/ the City rent such equipment from time to time for the efficient and economical prosecution of such improvements, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to rent from time to time the necessary equipment for the efficient and economical completion of improvements undertaken by the City in cooperation with the Works Progress Administration, and that he be authorized to pay rentals for the various equipment not to exceed the following schedule, to-wit:-

Paving Mixer	\$30.00 per day or \$400. per month
Small Concrete Mixer	8.00 " " " 150. " "
Road Roller (Up to 10 tons)	3.00 " hour.
Power Grader	3.00 " "
Power Planer or Maintainer	3.50 " "
Steel Curb Forms	7.00 per hundred feet per month.
Sewer Jacks	.50 each per month
Bulldozer	4.00 per hour
Compressor and Jack Hammers	15.00 per day
Mechanical Street Sweeper	2.50 per hour
Grinder	15.00 per day

Said above rates to be exclusive of drayage of equipment to and from the job.

Section 2. That the rentals of such equipment shall be paid from the funds appropriated or to be appropriated for each specific improvement upon which said equipment is used.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
