

ORDINANCE NO. 33-39

By Mr. Harlor

Authorizing the purchase of a street flusher or street cleaner.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one street flusher or one street cleaner with such equipment and specifications as they may deem best suited for the purpose of efficiently cleaning the streets and alleys in said city, the same not to exceed \$3600.00 in price.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement had according to law. The sum of \$3600.00 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, said emergency being that there is immediate need for the cleaning of said streets and alleys, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
