

ORDINANCE NO. 35-39

By Mr. Harlor

Providing for the repair of Main Street between Cassady Road and Drexel Avenue, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

Three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Main Street between Cassady Road and Drexel Avenue shall be repaired, in cooperation of the Work Projects Administration, or other governmental agency, by taking up those portions of the present pavement where the same is worn and in bad repair, and as directed by the engineers, repairing the concrete foundation, cleaning such bricks so taken up as are in proper condition for relaying, furnishing the necessary new bricks to complete said repairs, also other necessary materials therefor, and laying or replacing said brick surface, all in accordance with the estimates and specifications prepared by the engineers and on file in the office of the Mayor, and which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the entire cost of said repairs, except that portion to be performed or borne by the Work Projects Administration, or other governmental agency, shall be paid by the City of Belleville, and the sum of \$7000.00 is hereby appropriated from Streets Maintenance and Repair (KVL) Fund for that purpose.

Section 3. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized and directed to enter into a contract for that part of said improvement not to be performed by the Work Projects Administration, or other governmental agency, after advertisement according to law.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety, said emergency being that places in said street so in need of repair will render the same unsafe for public traffic.
