

ORDINANCE NO. 38-39

By Mr. Stackhouse

Providing for two additional patrolmen, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and hereby is authorized to appoint two additional patrolmen, in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 37-39.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and same shall go into immediate force and effect.
