ORDINANCE NO. 39-39

To provide for the disposition of well water used for cooling purposes.

whereas, there is developing in the City of Bexley an extensive use of water from drilled wells for the purpose of cooling theatres, stores and other places of business, and residences and apartments, and the disposition of the water so taken from said wells for that purpose has created a serious condition by reason of the same having been run into the sewer system of the City and thence into Alum Creek, resulting both in an over-loading of the sewers and in causing noxious and disagreeable oders throughout portions of the City by reason of sulphur content in said water, and

Whereas, it has been demonstrated that such water can be returned to the earth by means of a return pipe at a moderate expense, NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That where water from any drilled well is used for cooling purposes in the City of Bexley, such water shall not be run into any sewer, street or gutter, but it shall be returned to the earth by means of an additional drilled well, or wells, for such purpose. No such well, or return well, shall be drilled without written permit first obtained from the Mayor, and the same shall be drilled, cased, maintained and operated subject to the approval of the Mayor.

provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00, together with the costs of prosecution. Each separate day's violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense hereunder.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
