

ORDINANCE NO. 40-39

Authorizing payment of bill of Rodenfels Law Printing Company.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the bill of Rodenfels Law Printing Company for printing of briefs in the assessment cases of Gallagher, et al., v. City of Bexley, in the Supreme Court of Ohio, in the sum of \$38.12 be paid, and the Auditor is authorized to issue a proper voucher therefor. The sum of \$38.12 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the above purpose.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
