

ORDINANCE NO. 42-39

To vacate the alleys hereinafter named.

Whereas, petitions and consents of the persons owning all the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the alleys hereinafter named were duly presented to council praying that said alleys as therein described be vacated, and

Whereas, council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for said vacation as prayed for, and that such vacation will not be detrimental to the general interests, and further finds that said petitions and consents have been signed by all of the owners of the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said alleys between the points therein described, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the following alleys situated in the City of Bexley, to-wit:

- (a) That part of the second alley south of Astor Avenue, extending from Remington Road to Vernon Road.
- (b) The first alley south of Main Street from the first alley west of Euclaire Avenue to Euclaire Avenue,
- (c) The first alley north of Astor Avenue from Euclaire Avenue to the alley west of Euclaire Avenue.

be and the same are hereby vacated; reserving, however, to the city and public and quasi public corporation now or hereafter holding franchises and permits from the city for the supplying of water, gas, electricity, and telephone service, all necessary easements in, under or over said alleys, for the purpose of sewers, mains, poles, wires and conduits, and maintaining and keeping them in repair, so far as the city may deem to be necessary to supply its inhabitants with public utility service, sewers and drains.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
