

ORDINANCE NO. 45-39

To vacate the alleys hereinafter described.

Whereas, petitions and consent of the persons owning all the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the alleys hereinafter described have been duly presented to council praying that said alleys be vacated between the points hereinafter mentioned, and

Whereas, Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for said vacations as prayed for and that such vacations will not be detrimental to the general interests, and further finds that said petitions and consent have been signed by all of the owners of the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said alleys between said points, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the following described alleys in the City of Bexley, to-wit:

(a) The first alley east of Remington Road from Maryland Avenue to Ruhl Avenue,

(b) The first alley north of Livingston Avenue from Chelsea Avenue to the west line of the first alley east of Chelsea Ave.,

(c) The first alley south of Mound Street from Euclaire Avenue to the first alley west of Euclaire Avenue,

(d) That part of the second alley south of Astor Avenue, extending from Montrose Avenue to Remington Road,

(e) Being that portion of the first alley north of Astor Avenue, lying between Vernon Road and Roosevelt Avenue,

(f) Being the first alley north of Broad Street extending easterly from the east line of Stanwood Road a distance of 279.6 feet to the east end thereof,

be and the same are hereby vacated; reserving, however, to the city and public and quasi public corporation now or hereafter holding franchises and permits from the city for the supplying of water, gas, electricity, and telephone service, all necessary easements in, under or over said alleys, for the purpose of sewers, mains, poles, wires and conduits, and

maintaining and keeping them in repair, so far as the city may deem to be necessary, to supply its inhabitants with public utility service, sewers and drains.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
