

## ORDINANCE NO. 46-39

By Mr. Stackhouse

Authorizing the City Solicitor to employ special counsel to assist, in and to certify as to the legality of, proceedings in the issuance of notes and bonds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That whereas, it will greatly facilitate the sale and delivery of notes and bonds of the City of Bexley to be issued for the improvement of Cassady Road, to have the proceedings therefor supervised and the legality thereof certified by the firm of Squire, Sanders & Dempsey, Attorneys-at-Law, of Cleveland, Ohio, the Solicitor is hereby authorized and empowered to employ said attorneys as special counsel for said purpose to assist him in such issue of notes and bonds and to render their certificate as to the legality of such issues.

Section 2. The sum of Sixty Dollars (\$60.00) is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the cost and expense of said employment.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the period allowed by law.
