

## ORDINANCE NO. 47-39

To narrow the alley between Cassingham Road and Remington Road extending from Elm Avenue north to the south line of lots 271 and 272 of Ardmore Addition.

Whereas, the petition and consent of the persons owning all the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the hereinafter described alley has been duly presented to council praying that said alley may be narrowed to the width of 16 feet by vacating two feet on each side thereof, and

Whereas, council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for narrowing said alley by vacating two feet on each side thereof, and that the same will not be detrimental to the general interests, and further finds that said petition and consent have been signed by all of the owners of the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said alley between said points to be narrowed, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the alley between Cassingham Road and Remington Road extending from Elm Avenue north to the south line of lots 271 and 272 of Ardmore Addition in the City of Bexley be and the same is hereby narrowed by vacating two feet on each side thereof between said points; reserving, however, to the city and public and quasi public corporation now or hereafter holding franchises and permits from the city for the supplying of water, gas, electricity, and telephone service, all necessary easements in, under or over said alleys, for the purpose of sewers, mains, poles, wires and conduits, and maintaining and keeping them in repair, so far as the city may deem to be necessary to supply its inhabitants with public utility service, sewers and drains.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
