

ORDINANCE NO. 48-39

Whereas, under authority of Ordinance No. 16-37, duly passed May 11th, 1937, the City of Bexley improved Brentwood Road from Remington Road to Gould Road in cooperation with the Works Progress Administration, using therefor to pay the City's portion of said cost certain funds advanced by Lillian G. Johnson, being one of the abutting property owners, which funds were advanced by the said Lillian G. Johnson on behalf of herself and the owners of all the property bounding and abutting upon said improvement, under an agreement which provided as follows:-

"It is understood that said funds so to be deposited with the Auditor of the City of Bexley shall not become the funds of said City, but shall be used by said City to pay for that part of the cost of said improvement which shall be apportioned to said city under said application for said improvement, and that in the event said entire sum so to be deposited shall not be used in the payment of the City's portion of said cost, such sum so not used shall be repaid to the said Lillian G. Johnson for the benefit of herself and said property owners who shall have contributed to said fund,"

and

Whereas, said improvement has been completed and there remains of said funds so contributed by said Lillian G. Johnson on behalf of herself and said other property owners, the sum of \$1308.83, which under the terms of said agreement should be repaid to the said Lillian G. Johnson for the benefit of herself and said other property owners who contributed thereto, and

Whereas, the said Lillian G. Johnson has under date of September 6th, 1939 executed an agreement to the City of Bexley wherein she requests and directs that the City make distribution of said sum of \$1308.83 directly to said abutting property owners, as specifically listed in said agreement and in the amounts therein stated, as hereinafter shown, to-wit:

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1308.83 of the amount contributed by Lillian G. Johnson for the benefit of herself and abutting property owners for the improvement of Brentwood Road between Remington Road and Gould Road, as hereinabove set forth, which amount remains in the general fund after the completion of said improvement, be distributed to the above listed abutting property owners in accordance with the agreement of Lillian G. Johnson dated September 6th, 1939, and that the Auditor be authorized and directed to issue his vouchers to said respective persons and in said respective amounts.

Section 2. That the sum of \$1308.83 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the above purpose.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
