Providing for the repair and improvement of Astor

Avenue from College Avenue to Pleasant Ridge Avenue in cooperation with the Work Projects Administration of the United States

Government, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Astor Avenue from College Avenue to Pleasant Ridge Avenue shall be repaired and improved by the necessary grading, draining, constructing concrete curbs and gutters and re-surfacing the present macadem surface, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles prepared by the engineers and on file in the office of the Mayor, which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That said project shall be performed in cooperation with the Work Projects Administration of the Federal Government, which Administration has agreed to furnish the necessary labor and a portion of the materials therefor and to perform said work, and the balance of said materials in the estimated sum of \$2500.00 to be furnished by the City, together with engineering and other necessary costs. Whereas, the City has heretofore, after advertisement according to law, contracted for a supply of certain materials entering into such improvement, further advertisement shall not be made for such materials so contracted for, and the Mayor is authorized to purchase such additional materials as may be required under said plans and specifications.

Section 3. The sum of \$2500.00 is hereby appropriated from the Street Maintenance and Repair Gasoline Tax Fund for the above purpose.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said street is in

need of repair, and the same shall at once go into force and effect.
