

ORDINANCE NO. 61-39

by Mr. Boeshaar

Authorizing the purchase of screenings, stone dust,
Scioto rock, black rock, sand and gravel for the year 1940.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF
OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are
authorized, after advertisement had according to law, to enter
into contracts for the purchase and furnishing and delivering
of screenings, stone dust, Scioto rock, black rock, sand and
gravel to the City of Bexley for the year 1940.

Section 2. That the sum of \$10,000 is hereby appropriated
from Street Maintenance and Repair (Gas) Fund for the purpose
of paying the cost of said materials.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in
force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
