

ORDINANCE NO. 66-39

Providing for the office of Assistant Superintendent of Building.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the office of Assistant Superintendent of Building is hereby created, which position shall be exempt from the classified service. An Assistant Superintendent of Building shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council for a term of one year, or until his successor is appointed, and qualified. He shall receive a salary of \$1920.00 semi-per year, payable monthly. He shall also have in the sum of \$500.00. He shall assist the Superintendent of Building in the performance of duties prescribed in Section 2(a) of Ordinance No. 93-31, and shall perform such other duties as may hereafter be required by council.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
