

## ORDINANCE NO. 2-40

To provide for the/improvement of Ruhl Avenue from Northview Drive to Cassady Road.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Ruhl Avenue from Northview Drive to Cassady Road be improved by grading, macadamizing, surfacing and draining the surface thereof, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles therefor heretofore prepared by the engineers, which are hereby approved, and are now on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 2. That whereas, the Work Projects Administration of the United States of America has proposed and agreed to furnish all labor in the making of said improvement, and has proposed and agreed to perform said improvement at its own expense, on condition that the City of Bexley shall furnish the materials therefor, together with certain equipment and other direct costs, including engineering services, in accordance with the Works Progress Administration Form No. 301, now on file in the office of the Mayor, all of said city's portion of said cost being in the estimated sum of \$900.00, the council does hereby resolve that said improvement shall be made in cooperation with said Work Projects Administration, or other governmental agency, in accordance with said proposal and agreement.

Section 3. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to rent the necessary machinery and equipment for the doing of said work and to purchase the necessary materials therefor in the manner provided by law and to cause said work to be done under the supervision of the engineers.

Section 4. That the sum of \$900.00 is hereby appropriated from the Streets, Maintenance and Repair, Gasoline Tax Fund to provide for the cost of said improvement.

Section 5. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said street is in an impassible condition, dangerous to traffic, and should be improved without delay, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
