ORDINANCE NO. 6-40

Employing the Jennings-Lawrence Company as engineers for a period of one year, beginning January 1st, 1940 and ending December 31st, 1940.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Jennings-Lawrence Company, a corporation under the laws of the State of Ohio, with its place of business at Columbus, Ohio, be and the same is hereby employed as engineers for the City of Bexley for the term of one year beginning January 1st, 1940 and ending on the 31st day of December, 1940, the duties of said employment being the same as set forth in their contract of employment for the year 1939 as specifically defined and provided in Ordinance No. 14-39, passed March 27th, 1939, and the compensation therefor shall be at the same rate as set forth in said ordinance.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized and directed on behalf of the City to enter into a contract with said Jennings-Lawrence Company containing the same agreements and providing the same compensation as prescribed in said Ordinance No. 14-30, and the contract entered into in accordance therewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
