

ORDINANCE NO. 7-40

Accepting deeds of easement for storm water sewers from Edward R. Reeves and Ethel M. Schmitt.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the deed of Edward R. Reeves and Alice R. Reeves, his wife, for an easement, bearing date of January 8th, 1940, and the deed of Ethel M. Schmitt, bearing date of January 5th, 1940, each conveying an easement for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, operating and repairing a storm water sewer over the premises in said deeds described, be and the same are accepted, and the Auditor is directed to cause said deeds of easement to be duly filed in the office of the Recorder of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
