RESOLUTION NO. 11-40

Amending Section 3 of Resolution No. 2-38, declaring it necessary to improve Francis Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:
Three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Resolution No. 2-38, declaring it necessary to improve Francis Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue, by paving, curbing, constructing necessary sewers, drains and water lines, adopted January 25, 1938, be amended to read as follows:

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement less one-fiftieth thereof, and the cost of intersections, less also the cost of constructing said fire hydrants, shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from the improvement upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit: All lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be especially benefitted by said improvement in an amount not less than the cost thereof, and the cost of said improvement shall include the expense of the preliminary and other surveys and of printing and publishing the notices, resolution and ordinances required, and the serving of said notices, the cost of construction, together with interest on notes and bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of deferred assessments, and all other necessary expenditures.

It is hereby determined and declared that said improvement is conductive to the public health, convenience and welfare.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
