

ORDINANCE NO. 12-40

By Mr. O. F. Rehn

To establish additional non-parking areas.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That in addition to the non-parking areas established in paragraph (f) of Section 28 of Ordinance No. 47-36, the following non-parking areas are hereby established, and no vehicles shall be permitted to park or stand therein, to-wit:

- (a) Remington Road, between Fair Avenue and Main Street
- (b) The East side of Cassingham Road, between Main Street and Mound Street.

Section 2. That the Mayor shall cause appropriate traffic signs to be erected on Remington Road and Cassingham Road between said points, of the kind and in the manner heretofore provided by ordinance.

Section 3. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than \$25.00, and the costs of prosecution.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
