## RESOLUTION NO. 13-40

Appointing Board to report estimated assessment to pay the cost and expense of improving the alleys hereinafter named.

whereas, it has been determined by council to assess the entire part of the cost of improving the following alleys, less that portion thereof which is to be performed and borne by the Work Projects Administration, and less 1/50th of said remaining cost, and the cost of intersections, said assessment to be in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement, and which alleys are described as follows, to-wit:

- (a) The first alley south of Astor Avenue from Vernon Road to Roosevelt Avenue.
- (b) The first alley north of Astor Avenue from Remington Road to Vernon Road.
- (c) The first alley south of Main Street from Chelsea Avenue to the first alley east of Chelsea Avenue.
- (a) That part of the alley between Brentwood Foad and Benley Park Road extending westerly from Remington Road a distance of 100 feet.
- (e) The first alley east of Roosevelt Avenue extending from the north line of Bexley Highlands Amended Addition to the north line of Ardmore Addition No. 2.
- (f) The first alley east of Cassady Road from Maryland Avenue to Ruhl Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEZLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Robert J. Wheaton, Grover Orr and Frank Hamilton, three disinterested free-holders of said city, be and they are hereby appointed a Board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith, as set forth in an Ordinance No. 5-40, to improve said alleys, passed March 5th, 1940, in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from the improvement to the several lots or parcels of land so assessed and report to this council the said estimated assessment.
