ORDINANCE NO. 14-40

Appropriating money to pay that part of the City's portion of the cost and expense of improving certain alleys in the City of Bexley which is not to be borne by the Work Projects Administration.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
