ORDINANCE NO. 18-40

Amending Section 4 of Ordinance No. 16-39, providing for the improvement of Stanwood Road from Elm Avenue to Powell Avenue, passed April 11th, 1939.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 16-39, determin ing to proceed with the improvement of Stanwood Road from Elm Avenue to Powell Avenue, passed April 11th, 1939, be amended to read as follows:

Section 4. That in accordance with said petitions the entire cost of said improvement, less that portion which is to be performed and borne by said Works Progress Administration, and less the cost of water connections, shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from the improvement upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit: all lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said proposed improvement, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement, in an amount not less than the cost thereof, and the cost of said improvement shall include the expense of the preliminary and other surveys, and of the printing and publishing of notices, resolutions and ordinances required, the serving of said notices, the cost of construction, together with interest on notes and bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of deferred assessments, and of all other necessary expenditures, as provided in said proposal and agreement of said Works Progress Administration. The cost of water connections shall be paid from the Water Fund, and the said fund shall be reimbursed by a charge to the respective property owners at such time as they shall complete their connections therewith for the purpose of obtaining water service.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
