

## RESOLUTION NO. 18-40

Providing for posting of notice of vacation of Fulton Street from Euclaire Avenue to Montrose Avenue.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That whereas, a petition has been filed by the owners of lots and lands in the City of Bexley in the immediate vicinity of Fulton Street from Euclaire Avenue to Montrose Avenue praying for the vacation of said street between said points subject to the conditions and reservations in said petition contained, it is hereby ordered that the Clerk of Council cause notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition to be posted in three or more public places, being the places where ordinances are posted, for six weeks preceding action upon said petition.
