

ORDINANCE NO. 21-40

By Mr. Harlor

Providing for purchase of Inhalator and Accessories
for use of Department of Public Safety.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE
OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they
are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the
purchase of an Inhalator complete with two 16 cu. ft.
cylinders of Carbogen, and with Auxilliary attachment for
converting 1-patient inhalator to a 2-patient type, complete
with carrying case, also two spare 16 ft. carbogen cylinders
and carrying case, such Inhalator to be of type approved
by American Medical Association, and same, together with
above equipment, to cost not to exceed \$250.00

Section 2. The sum of \$250.00 is hereby appropriated
from General Fund for the above purpose.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure,
necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
health and safety, and the same shall go into immediate
force and effect.
