

ORDINANCE NO. 22-40


Appropriating and setting aside moneys in the General Bond Fund for debt charges accruing in 1941 on outstanding general unvoted bonds.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$7295.76 be and the same is hereby appropriated and set aside in the General Bond Fund, to be used to meet all debt charges accruing in 1941 on outstanding general unvoted bonds of the City, and the Trustees of the Sinking Fund are authorized to so set aside said amount for said purpose.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
