

ORDINANCE NO. 23-40

By Mr. Harlor

Appropriating and transferring moneys from the
General Fund to the Special Assessment Bond Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE
OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1572.44 be and the same
is hereby appropriated and set aside from the General Fund
to be paid into the Special Assessment Bond Fund to be used
only for the payment of interest accruing in the year 1941
on outstanding special assessment bonds of the City of Bexley.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be
in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
