

ORDINANCE NO. 28-40

By Mr. Altmaier

Providing for payment of bill to Harley E. Peters,
Solicitor, in case of Donley vs. City of Bexley.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE
OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the bill of Harley E. Peters,
Solicitor, for services rendered in Common Pleas Court of
Franklin County, Ohio in case of W. E. (Eugene) Donley,
Plaintiff in Error, vs. City of Bexley, Defendant in Error,
No. 158,415 in said court, in the sum of \$50.00 be allowed
and paid, and said sum of \$50.00 is appropriated from
General Fund for said purpose.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be
in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
