

## ORDINANCE NO. 52-40

By Mr. Altmaier

Providing for the repairing of Fair Avenue from Drexel Avenue to Remington Road.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Fair Avenue from Drexel Avenue to Remington Road shall be repaired by removing the present sheet asphalt surface, repairing the foundation and curbs where needed, and re-surfacing said avenue with asphaltic concrete surface, and doing the other things necessary and incidental thereto, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of the proposed improvement heretofore prepared by the engineers and now on file in the office of the Mayor, which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the entire cost of the making of said repairs and improvement shall be paid by the City of Bexley, and the sum of \$15,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for that purpose.

Section 3. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for said improvement and repairs after advertisement according to law.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety, in that said street is in a condition dangerous to traffic, and should be immediately repaired, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
