ORDINANCE NO. 35-40

By Mr. Kurtz

Establishing bus stand in Main Street at Drexel Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINLD BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EMPLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That a stand is hereby established for the use of busses authorized to furnish transportation of passengers for hime on the streets of Bexley at the following location, to-wit: Being an area 9 feet in width extending along the north curb line of Main Street from the east line of Drexel Avenue extended to a point 40 feet east thereof.

Appropriate signs shall be erected by the Mayor clearly marking said area as a bus stand.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for the driver to stand or park any bus upon any street in a business district except in a designated bus stand.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any vehicle other than a bus to stand or park in an officially designated bus stand.

Section 4. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall on conviction therefor be fined not to exceed \$10.00, together with the costs of prosecution.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
